

ASSEMBLY HONORS

OGDEN WOMAN



For the first time, the Ogden Trades and Labor Assembly unanimously beckoned the finger of honor to a woman, when it elected Mrs. Frank Hvizdalek, of Schoolteachers union No. 78, to the first vice-presidency of that body.

Vice president Hvizdalek is a teacher in the Ogden public schools. She is a graduate of the Nebraska State university, of Lincoln, Nebr. She also is a post-graduate of the University of Chicago.

Mrs. Hvizdalek showed Monday night by her handling of the business of her office, that she is a shrewd, smart young woman, like her American sisterhood, able to meet any situation and occupy many positions that mankind has formerly refused her.
